Understanding modified cars

A car with modifications can allow an injured person to brake, accelerate and use secondary controls like indicators/horn etc. with their hands.

For clients with a range of leg and arm injuries, supply of a rental vehicle like this gives them real independence.

What injuries are modified vehicles suitable for?

- » Foot, leg, hand and arm injuries
- » People who are recovering from surgery on their leg, foot, hand or arm
- » Hip and Back injuries.

- » Increased independence, improved well-being and quicker recovery
- » Get back to work and everyday life, needing less paid or unpaid assistance
- » More convenient and flexible than taxis, and can be cheaper with hires starting from only \$54 a day.

Radial Hand Controls

Simple to operate: downward movement to operate the accelerator and push forward action for braking.



Push/Pull Hand Controls

The Push/Pull design has no downward movement, just a simple push for braking and pull for acceleration.

A range of other modifications available.

Which clients benefit most?

- » Those who are self-employed or who drive a lot for work
- » People who live rurally or remotely with limited access to taxi services
- » Client situations where the cost of long taxi journeys is prohibitive
- » Those with dependents
- » Clients who need to attend a lot of appointments
- » Shift workers
- » Primary caregivers for others, including the elderly, people with disabilities, sick relatives
- » Single parents
- » Clients with a long and isolating rehab period, who may be at risk of getting depressed.

Driving familiarisation lesson included

- » Driving lessons are carried out by a fully-qualified instructor
- » A typical lesson will run through the hand controls, getting the client driving the car independently and practising common driving manoeuvres
- » During instruction the aim is to use roads the client will need to drive regularly during their recovery.

Key criteria:

- Can they control the vehicle?
- Are they safe?
- Are they safe to other road users?
- Are they confident operating the controls?
